On October 28th our 8th grade hosted a Spooktacular Halloween Costume Party for our 6th, 7th and 8th graders.

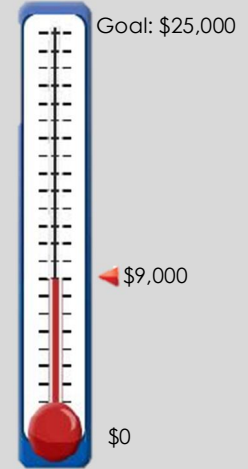
